

Informal Deficiency Resolutions (IDR): Secrets for Success

- 1. Provide a "SMART" LIFE SAFETY PLAN to the surveyor at the start of the survey.
- 2. Take GOOD NOTES during the survey; mark each potential cite location on the life safety plan with a number that links it with your notes.
- 3. Avoid requesting an IDR if it's easy to FIX; or you're going to fix it anyway. It makes the reviewer roll their eyes for wasting their time.
- 4. Don't be afraid to IDR cites that are wrong; it helps EDUCATE the surveyor from doing the same thing to someone else.
- 5. Include the LIFE SAFETY PLAN with your IDR submittal and show the location of each issue on the plan.
- 6. Include a close-up DRAWING of each IDR location, marked to show the reviewer the key points of the situation.
- 7. Include PHOTOS to illustrate the situation & support facility position; mark with comments to explain what needs to be seen.
- 8. QUOTE the full wording of the appropriate codes.
- 9. EXPLAIN why the cited code was not correctly applied.
- 10. If using a consultant, contact them IMMEDIATELY after the survey; don't wait to receive the SOD because you don't have much time to prepare the submittal.
- 11. If using a consultant, have them generate the IDR SUPPORT DOCUMENTS.
- 12. Have a knowledgeable code expert on the phone during the IDR CONFERENCE CALL to support your contention and respond to questions from the reviewer.
